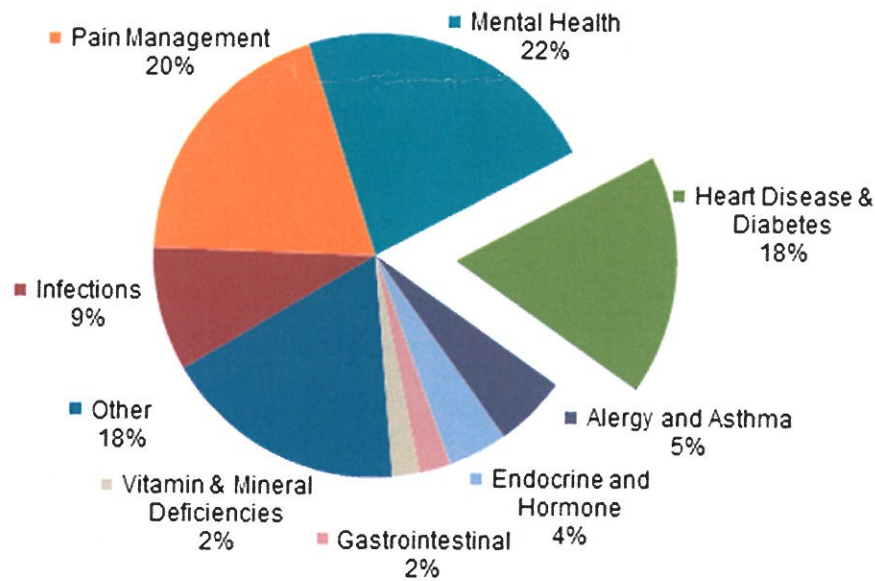


Health Impact with FamilyWize

Lowering the cost of medication enables more people to get the medicine they need and increases patient adherence. Taking medication as prescribed reduces illness, complications, disease progression, and related healthcare costs. These reduced costs to the patient, the family, the employer and the community are far greater than the cost of the medicine.
